Racing Rules Seminar

Duration: 1 day

Cost: Free

These seminars offer sailors, parents, coaches and beginners to judging an opportunity to become more familiar with the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), judging processes and the roles of judges. They will be facilitated by National and International Judges.

This is an opportunity to gain more in-depth knowledge about the rules (with a special emphasis on Part 2: When Boats Meet) and to gain an insight at how judges interpret and apply the rules.

Racing Rules Seminar knowledge is presumed at National Judging Seminars.

The seminar will be based on the following outline of topics:

- Judging basics (The objectives and standards involved in judging the sport of sailing)
- Racing rules definitions
- Rules of RRS Parts 1 and 2.
- Rules of RRS Parts 3 to 6.
- Judging processes, arbitration, hearings (protest and redress), On Water Judging (Appendix P and Observation),
