### **NOTICE OF RACE**

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V, Category C shall apply upgraded so that all boats competing must carry a VHF radio transceiver capable of receiving and transmitting VHF channel 77.  
A minimum of 5 litres of fuel shall be carried at the start of racing.
- 1.3 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

#### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Noelex 22 class that comply with class rules and whose owners are current financial members of the Noelex 22 Trailer Yacht Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Admin, Naval Point Club Lyttelton, PO Box 19733, Woolston, Christchurch 8241, by Monday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2019

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 1800 hrs Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019.

- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority. Proof of affiliated club membership to be presented at registration.

- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 10.55

- 5.6 On Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> January no warning signal will be made after 15.30 hours.

#### **6 MEASUREMENTS**

- 6.1 Sails, spars, weight, and safety gear will be measured and checked.

- 6.2 A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. A safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

#### **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after registration and draft Sailing Instructions will be available on the Naval Point Club Lyttelton website [www.navalpoint.co.nz](http://www.navalpoint.co.nz) from January 1 2019.

#### **8 VENUE**

- 8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.

- 8.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing areas.

#### **9 THE COURSES**

The courses to be sailed will be Triangle / Windward Leeward.

#### **11 SCORING**

5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

**12 LAUNCHING**

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Naval Point Club slipway. [DP]

**13 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

**14 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

The line honours winner of the championship will be awarded the Noelex 22 Class Trophy and Plate.

The handicap winner will be awarded the Noelex 22 Handicap Trophy.

A Family Trophy will be awarded to the boat crewed by family members that is highest placed.

**15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**16 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability marine insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000.00 per event or the equivalent.

Certificate of insurance is to be presented at registration.
