*2019 International Tornado New Zealand National Championship are being held From the 30th December 2018, to the 3rd January 2019, at **Takapuna Beach, Stanmore Bay, Whangaparaoa**–New Zealand. That regatta is preceding the 2019 International Tornado World, Global Mixed and Youth Championship, being held from the 4th January - 10th January 2019 at the same location.*

NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The ITA Class Rules "Appendix C - International Events" and the "Equipment Inspection Regulation" will apply.
- 1.4 Racing rule A4.1 will be amended to include 'a boat starting later than 10 minutes after the starting signal will be scored DNS'. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising



authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

- 2.2 After the first day when races are completed, the first 3 boats in the provisional standings may be required to display a yellow, blue or red disc on the mainsail.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International Tornado class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to

- 3.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority.

Proof of affiliated club membership to be presented at registration.

- 3.4 Each entrant shall be skippered by a member of the NZ International Tornado Association.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

- NZ\$200, if paid by the 31st August 2018
- NZ\$250, if paid by the 30th September 2018
- NZ\$350, if paid after the 30th September 2018
- Entries close on the 30th December 2018.

- 4.2 The Entry Fee includes an NZITA Class Fee of NZ\$50 (Fifty New Zealand Dollars).

- 4.3 The Entry Fee is non-refundable.

- 4.4 Entry Fees have to be paid by the methods noted below.

5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the practice race is 15:30 and no warning signal will be made after 16:30.

5.6 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 16:00



6 MEASUREMENT

- 6.1 Equipment Inspection shall be conducted in accordance with the Tornado Equipment Inspection Regulations, copies of which will be available on the event [website](#) and the **Takapuna Boating Club website** from the 1st December 2018 and at the Race Office at the Takapuna Boating Club from the **30th December 2018 from 09:00am**.
- 6.2 Each boat shall present a valid measurement certificate at Equipment Inspection.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after the **1st December 2018** online at New Zealand International Tornado Association [Website](#) and the **Takapuna Boating Club website** and from the Race Office **at the Takapuna Boating Club** from the 30th December 2018 from 09:00am.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 Attachment B shows the location of the regatta venue, and the location of the race area.

9 THE COURSE

- 9.1 The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1 For the Tornado class RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- 10.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in RRS 70.5.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- a) When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.



- b) When six (6) to nine (9) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

- 12.1 Support boats shall be marked with a red disc. [DP]
- 12.2 Team leaders, coaches and support personnel shall register from the 30th November 2018 via email (multihullers@gmail.com) and shall comply with the requirements in the Sailing Instructions.

13 STORAGE

- 13.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park . [DP]

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 14.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
- Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 teams.
 - Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 "Mixed" teams.
 - Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 "Classic Tornado" teams.
 - Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 "Youth Tornado" teams. Each crew member under 26 years old as at the 31st December 2019. - Proof of age will be required.
 - *Special Prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority to teams who attend the prize giving ceremony.*

16 INSURANCE

- 16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of One million dollars (\$1,000,000) per incident or the equivalent. Certificate of insurance is to be presented at registration.



17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 Photography Consent

- 18.1 By entering the Championship competitors accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the race and/or using the regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, re-use, publication and re-publication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

ATTACHMENT A: CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE

COURSE ILLUSTRATION

1. The Course:

- for the new rig Tornado is:

Start -1- 2- 3S / 3P - 1-2-3S/3P - 1- 2 – Finish

- for the Classic Tornado is:

Start – 1 – 2 – 3S/3P – 1 – 2 - Finish

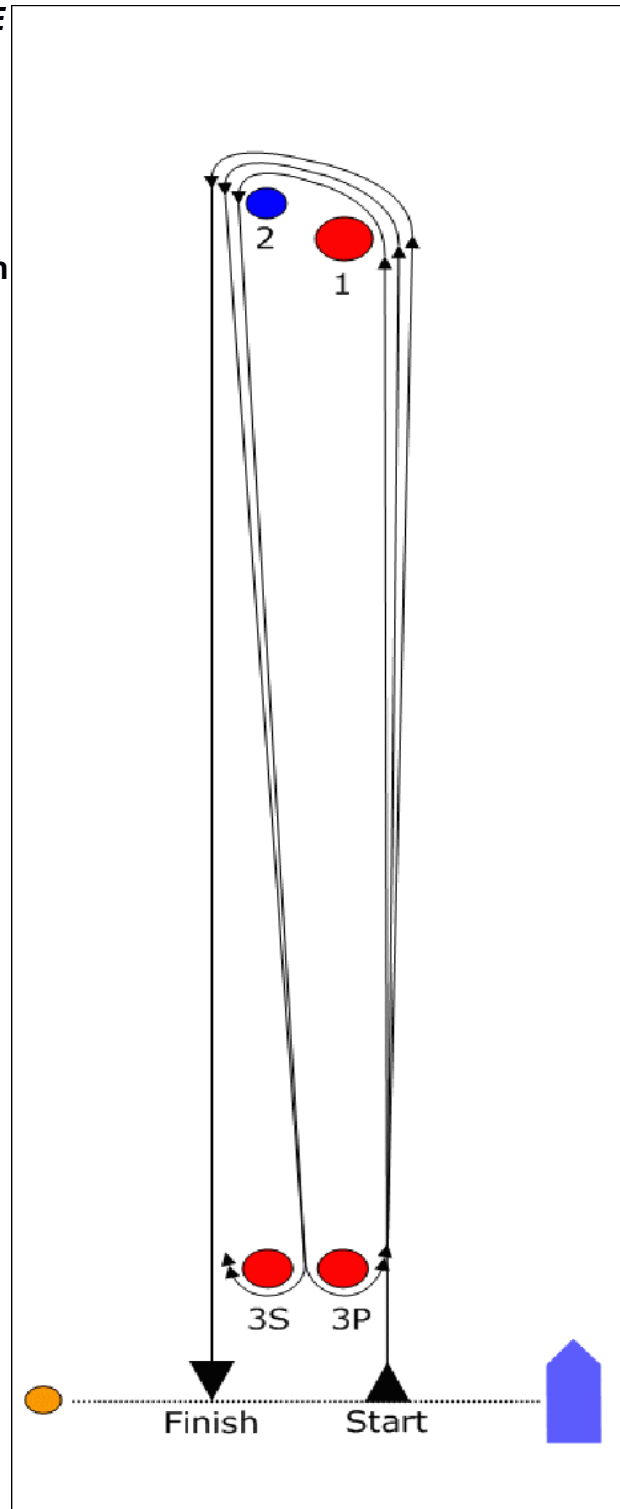
1. Marks 1 & 2, the windward marks, shall be rounded to port.

2. Mark 2 shall be set approximately 100 meters to port of Mark 1. The bearing to Mark 2 from Mark 1 shall be approximately 70 degrees to port of the bearing to Mark 1 from the Start or previous leeward gate.

3. Marks 3S/3P may be disregarded on the first windward leg and on the final downwind leg.

4. Marks 3S and 3P, the leeward marks, shall be set as a gate.
Mark 3S shall be rounded to starboard or
Mark 3P shall be rounded to port.

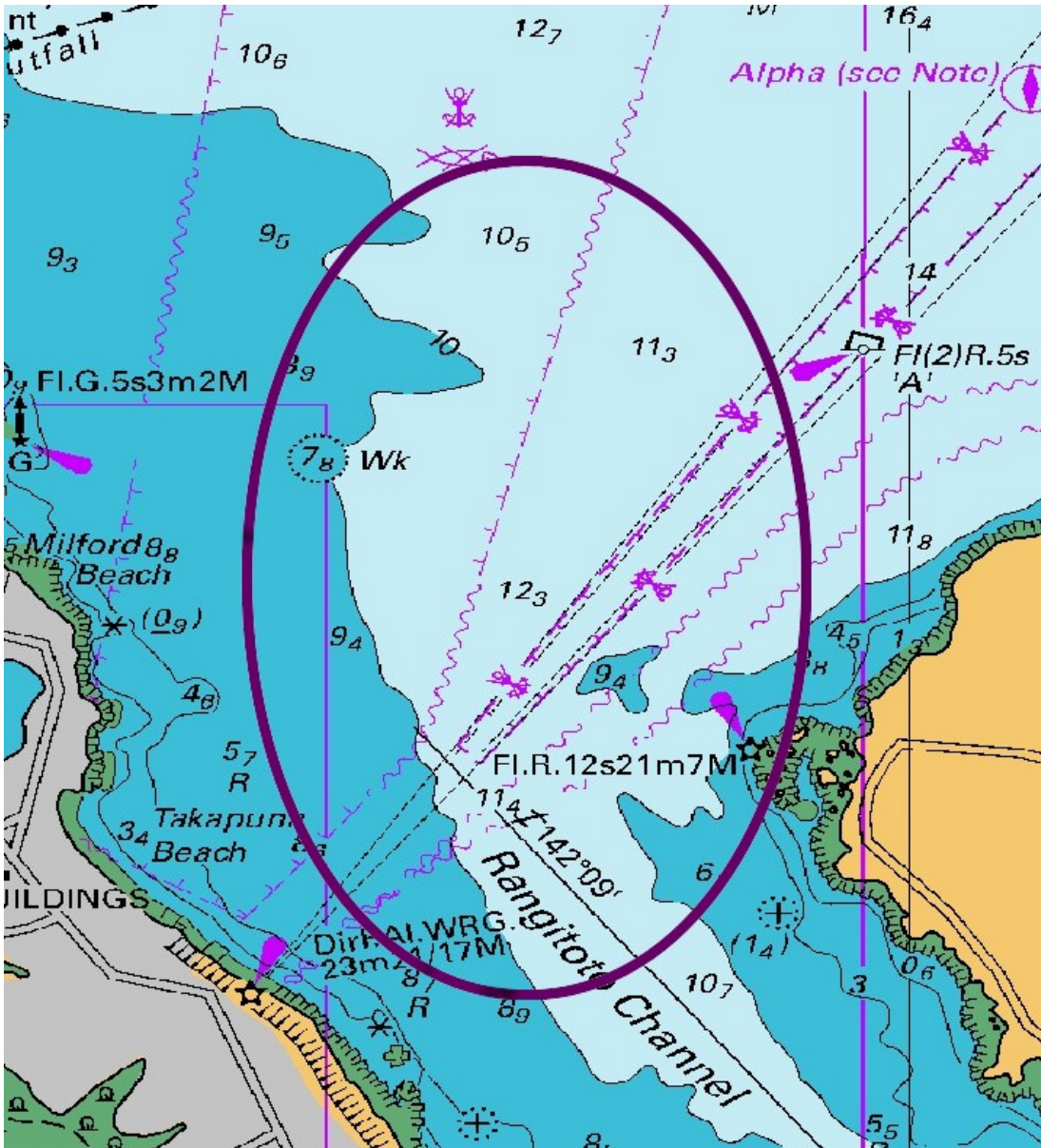
5. The Course length shall normally be set so the race will last approximately 60 minutes in the anticipated wind conditions. Failure to comply with this paragraph will not be grounds for a request for redress.
