- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* 2017-2020 edition
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- **1.3** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to P Class, Optimist, Starling, Firebug, Open Bic and any other Junior Class with two or more to constitute a class.
- **2.2** Each competitor must be a financial member of a club recognised by Yachting New Zealand
- **2.3** Entries will be available at the CYC from 2 hours prior to the races.
- 2.4 Sign-on and sign-off sheet is provided, and skippers failing to complete the sign-on or sign-off may be penalised at the discretion of the Protest Committee

3 Entry Fees

3.1 Entry Fee for two days is \$40.00 or \$8.00 per Race

- c. When four or more races have been completed, a boats score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score.
- d. For qualifying classes, final results count towards CYA Traveller Series
