NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1, shall apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 Appendix T, arbitration, will apply.

2 CLASS RULES

- 2.1 The Laser class rules are changed as follows;
 - Rule 7 (a) is deleted and replaced by:
 - The laser shall be raced by one person onboard. The crew shall not change during the event.
- 2.2 Sailors using non class legal equipment (may sail but) will not be eligible for the championship or trophies.

3 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Laser class including Laser Open, Laser Radials, and Laser 4.7.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee of \$50.00, to Nelson Yacht Club (address on entry form) or email to lnfo@nelsonyachtclub.org.nz by Monday 26 November 2018.
- 4.3 Late entries will be accepted until 0930 on Saturday 1 December when accompanied by a \$20.00 late entry fee.
- 4.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.2 Registration and Briefing will be held at the Nelson Yacht Club.
- 5.3 A total of 6 races are scheduled for each class.
- 5.4 Depending on sufficient entries being received, there will be separate starts for Laser, Laser Radial and Laser 4.7's. Should a low number of entries be received for a class, starts may be combined.
- 5.5 On Sunday 2 December no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration, early drafts may be published online by the organisers.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue
- 7.2 Attachment B shows the location of the racing area.

8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be trapezoid.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - (a) When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When from four to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 9.2 Laser Open and Laser Open Masters will race and be scored as one fleet. The winner of this class will be the Laser South Island Champion. The relative placing in this fleet will determine the placing in the separate divisions.
- 9.3 Radial Open, Radial Woman, Radial Youth and Radial Master will race and be scored as one fleet. The relative placing in this class will determine the placing in the separate divisions.
- 9.5 Laser 4.7 will race and be scored as one fleet.

10 SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration.
- 10.2 Support Boats shall keep at least 100 metres from the race area while boats are racing.
- 10.3 There will be a support boat driver briefing for all support boat drivers and crew after registration.

11 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Nelson Yacht Club slipway.

12 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones

13 PRIZES

Prizes will be given for 1st place in each class (Open, Radial and 4.7).

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. It is the responsibility of each sailors, and where applicable the nominated responsible adult to decide to participate in a race o to continue racing. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
