#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed under the Current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) Safety regulations part II category 5 shall apply to all keel boats.
- 1.3 The YNZ safety regulations part V category B shall apply to all trailer yachts.
- 1.4 The YNZ safety regulations part VI Category B shall apply to all sports boats.
- 1.5 Should there be any conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SIs) the SIs shall prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.
- 1.6 The racing Rules:
  - 1 Yachts with movable ballast, in the form of canting keel or water ballast may move that ballast to increase or decrease weight, or to change trim and stability. This changes RRS 51. RRS 52 shall not apply to the adjustment of canting keel or water ballast.
    - 2 **Powered winches** either electric or hydraulic are permitted. This changes RRS 52.
  - 3 **Sports Boats** Category B Rule 12 will be changed to read, Outboard motors must be carried and stowed so that they can be used within amaximum of 5 minutes. This is because there may not be rescue boats in attendance.
  - 4 Yachts with lifting keels shall have keels locked in the down position and not moved whilst racing.
- 1.7 Auto pilots may be used for Divisions 4 and 5
- 1.8 A random number of safety checks will be undertaken during the regatta, prior to racing each day.
- 2 **ADVERTISING** (APPENDIX 1 Regulation 20.0)
- 2.1 Advertising on a **boat**, **personal equipment** or any other object on board a **boat** shall be displayed in accordance with this Code, the applicable **classrules** and the rules of the relevant System. Advertising that is not specifically permitted under this Code is prohibited.
- 2.2 Subject to the provisions of Regulation 20.6, the Organizing Authority may require that **boats** display the Advertising listed in this Regulation 20.4.1,provided that such requirement is stated in the notice of race and that the Organizing Authority provides the **boats** with the needed materials (stickers, flags, etc.):

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all keel boats, sports boat, trailer yacht and sports trailer yacht classes

The organising authority reserves the right to re-allocate an entrant into a more suitable division to ensure fair competition in a division. Four yachts will constitute a division.

- 3.3 Entries will be accepted by completing the attached entry form and paying the entry fee and sending it to Waikawa Boating Club (WBC).
- 3.4 Early bird entry fees received before 16 November 2018

Division 1, 2 and 3 \$110 (gst inc) Division 4 and 5 \$75 (gst inc)

Entries received after 16 November 2018

Division 1, 2 and 3 \$125 (gst inc) Division 4 and 5 \$85 (gst inc)

Entries close on Monday 7 January 2019.

Late entries, together with a late entry fee of \$75 (gst inc), may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 1700hrs on Friday 11 January 2019.

3.5 To be eligible to compete in this event, all competitors shall be a financial

member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority. When paid the entry fee covers temporary membership of WBC for all competitors for the duration of the regatta.

4.11 One additional race may be held on Day 1 for each division if deemed In order to achieve a regatta result.

4.2 No race shall start after 1515 on Sunday 13 January 2019.

#### 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available at registration from 1300 Friday 11 January 2019 as well as on the WBC website <a href="https://www.waikawaboatingclub.co.nz">www.waikawaboatingclub.co.nz</a>

#### 6 RACING AREA & COURSES

- 6.1 The courses for Divisions 1,2 and 3 will be held in the inner Queen Charlotte Sound. The courses will be a variety of trapezoidal or windward/leeward courses.
- 6.2 The Harbour Racing divisions courses may take them throughout Queen Charlotte Sound.

#### 7 SCORING SYSTEM

- 7.1 The Low-points scoring system of Appendix A will apply
- 7.2 Divisions 1,2 and 3 Divisions where 6 races have been completed a yacht score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. 4 Races to constitute a series.
- 7.3 Harbour Racing Divisions where 4 races have been completed a yachts score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. 2 races to constitute a series.

#### 8 HANDICAPPING

- 8.1 All yachts shall race in the same condition and carry the same equipment onboard as at the time their regatta handicap was established.
- 8.2 All yachts will be handicapped by the WBC official handicappers and these handicaps will be available on the website at 10 am on Thursday 10 January 2019, or for late entrants, prior to the warning signal for race 1.
- 8.3 The handicapper's decision will be final.

#### 9 PRIZES

- 9.1 There will be cash prizes and product prizes.
- 9.2 There will be prizes awarded for every race in the regatta
- 9.3 Prizes will be awarded on handicap and line honours for each division
- 9.4 There will be spot prizes on the Friday and Saturday evenings following prizegiving in the clubhouse
- 9.5 An overall prizegiving for the Lawsons Dry Hills New Year Regatta will be held in the wardroom at the completion of racing on the 13 of January 2019

#### 10 PROTESTS

- 10.1 For protests where only a rule of part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing may be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 10.2 The time limit for protests to be lodged with Race committee is 90 minutes after the last yacht has finished on that day.

#### 11 TEAM SUPPORT BOATS

- 11.1 Team support boats will be allowed.
- 11.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at registration.

#### 12 BERTHING

WBC will make every endeavour to find berths in the marina at Waikawa for out of town competitors. Those competitors that require berths should contact the WBC as soon as possible.

#### 13 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

13.1 All competing yachts and support boats must have a marine VHF transceiver with enough battery capacity to be still fully operational at the end of each day

#### 14 INSURANCE

14.1 All competing vessels are required to carry a minimum of 3<sup>rd</sup> party insurance for racing of \$2 million and it is a requirement if berthing in the Marina.

#### 15 DISCLAIMER

- 15.1 Although the WBC and its volunteers do everything they can to ensure the safety of the competitors, all competitors participate entirely at their own risk and responsibility. See Rule 4, decision to race RRS.
- 15.2 The WBC is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht whose entry is accepted and/or the sufficiency and/or adequacy of its equipment, or the competence of its skipper or crew.
- 15.3 The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the series.
- 15.4 Skippers and crew are reminded about their responsibilities on the water when it comes to the consumption of alcohol.
