

53rd Hartley 16 & Ross 780 National Championship 6th to 9th February 2019 New Plymouth Yacht Club

Notice of Race

The Organising Authority is the New Plymouth Yacht Club Inc. Ocean View Parade P.O. Box 576, New Plymouth.

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Hartley 16 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply Ross 780 – The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part V, Category C shall apply upgraded to include a marine VHF transceiver.
- 1.3 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats [shall] [may be required to] display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Hartley 16 and Ross 780 class that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of their respective Class Associations.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the contest entry form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Hartley/Ross Nats, New Plymouth Yacht Club, P.O.Box 576, New Plymouth or by emailing the contest entry form to jasonholdt@gmail.com and depositing the required entry fee into the following bank account 15-3942-0003460-00 and providing the following details Particulars Boat Name; Code Sail Number; and Reference Helmsperson Surname

Completed entries and fully paid entry fees must be received by Wednesday 23rd January 2019.

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at the race committee's discretion until 1700 hours Wednesday 6th February 2019.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a affiliated club recognized by the entrant and crew member's national authority.

4 FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Contest Entry Fee \$120.00

Late Entry Fee (additional) \$50.00

5 SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration – NPYC Clubhouse

Wednesday 6th February 2019 From 1300 to 1500 hours

5.2 Measurement and inspection – NPYC Clubhouse

Wednesday 6th February 2019 From 1300 to 1500 hours

5.3 Briefing, AGM and welcome – NPYC Clubhouse

Wednesday 6th February 2019 AGM – 1700 hours, Briefing - 1800 hours

5.4 Racing schedule:

Thursday 7th February 2019 3 races back to back. Friday 8th February 2019 3 races back to back. Saturday 9th February 2019 3 races back to back.

- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the contest each day is 1100 hours.
- 5.6 On Saturday 9th February 2019 no warning signal will be made after 1600 hours.

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Boats will be weighed and other measurements taken to ensure boats meet class rules and safety regulations. Any sails not previously signed will also be measured.
- A safety declaration is to be completed at registration. NB: a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Wednesday 6th February 2019 at the New Plymouth Yacht Club.

8 VENUE & RACING AREA

The venue is the New Plymouth Yacht Club. The sailing area is on the waters off Port Taranaki. See attachment A & B.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the Hartley 16 and Ross 780 classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

(a) Hartley 16 Fleet

When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 6 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score

(b)Ross 780 Fleet

When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from 6 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. When 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Ngamotu Beach at the New Plymouth Yacht Club or the ramp on Ocean View Parade.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

14 PRIZES

Line Honors Handicap First Family crewed boast Other prizes may also be awarded

Ross 780

Line honours Handicap Other prizes may be awarded.
