NOTICE OF RACE

1 The Organising Authority

1.1 The organising authority is the Waitara Boating Club, 1 West Beach, Waitara.

2 Rules

2.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020.

2.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.

3 Changes to Racing Rules

3.1 None

4 Eligibility and Entry

4.1 The regatta is open to all centreboard classes that comply with their Class Rules. If insufficient entries are received to make up a class (a minimum of 3 yachts), yachts will be grouped into Open Classes.

4.2 Entries will be accepted between 09:00hrs and 10:30hrs on Saturday 26th January 2019 by completing the attached entry form accompanied by the appropriate fee.

4.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by Yachting New Zealand.

5 Schedule of Events

5.1 Registration Saturday 26th January 2019 – 09:00 to 10:30 hours at Waitara Boating Club.

5.2 Briefing Saturday 26th January 2019 at 11:00 hrs at Waitara boating Club.

5.3 Racing Schedule

	All Fleets
Saturday 26 th January 2019	Race 1 First warning signal 12:00 hrs Race 2 and 3 back to back.
Sunday 27 th January 2019	Race 4 First warning signal 13:00 hrs. Race 5 and 6 back to back.

5.4 At the discretion of the race officers additional races maybe held on the Sunday to make up for any lost on the Saturday, subject to the latest time for the last warning signal being no later than 16:00 hrs.

6 Prize giving

6.1 Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday.

7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 The amended Waitara Boating Club Sailing Instructions will apply. Copies will be available at registration.

8 Racing Area and Courses

8.1 The races will be held in the vicinity of the Waitara River.

8.2 The courses may be windward leeward or triangle windward/leeward or a combination thereof.

9 Alternative Penalties

9.1 Refer Waitara Boating Club Sailing Instructions

10 Scoring

10.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta

10.2 When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores.

10.3 When 6 races have been completed, a boat's regatta score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.4 Open Mixed classes will be scored using Yardstick Handicapping

11 Prizes

11.1 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes will be awarded in each class, dependent on number of entries.

12 Launching

12.1 All dinghies must be launched and retrieved from the ramp in front of the Waitara Boating Club.

12.2 Trailer yachts are to be launched and retrieved from either the boat ramp in front of the Waitara Boating Club or the main boat ramp on the Waitara River.

13 Disclaimer of Liability

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
