1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 will apply.
- 1.3 The P Class Rules will apply
- 1.4 Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the P Class that comply with the Class Rules.

- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing and sending the attached entry form, along with the entry fee to arrive at the Tauranga Yacht & Powerboat Club no later than 1700hrs 18th October 2019. Send entries and payment to PO Box 14352, Tauranga 3143, New Zealand. or by Email and direct debit to our bank account **ANZ Bank Tauranga 01-0434-0082955-00**.
- 3.3 Late entries may be accepted up until 0830hrs on 26th October 2019.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority. Each competitor is required to submit proof of current membership.
- 3.5 Each competitor shall be under the age of 17 years on 26th October 2019. Each competitor is required to submit proof of age.

4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:
Contest Entry Fee is \$80.00

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Registration is from 0800hrs to 0930hrs on Saturday 26th October 2019.
- 5.2 Briefing is at 0930hrs on Saturday 26th October 2019.
- 5.3 Dates of racing:
Saturday 26th October 2019 four races back to back
Sunday 27th October 2019 four races back to back
- 5.4 The warning signal for the first race each day will be, 1125hr.
- 5.5 On Sunday the 27th October 2019 no warning signal will be made after 1530 hours.
- 5.6 Prize giving will be held after the final race on Sunday the 27th October 2019.

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate on request.
- 6.2 Beach trailers shall be prominently marked with the boat's number.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available upon registration.

8 VENUE

- 8.1 Is the Tauranga Yacht & Power Boat Club (Inc). At the end of Sulphur Point Tauranga.
- 8.2 Briefing, registration and measurement will be at the Tauranga Yacht and Powerboat Club
- 8.3 The races will be held within the confines of the Tauranga Harbour.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: The Two Turns Penalty is replaced by a one turn Penalty.

11 SCORING

- 11.1 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2 (a) When fewer than six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series

score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When six (6) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 SUPPORT BOATS

12.1 Support boats are permitted but their movements may be restricted.

12.2 Support boats must be registered with the Organising Authority at Registration.

13 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from in front of the TYPBC.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows;

First place North Island P Class Championship Trophy

Second and third places

First female competitor

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

15.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, see Rule 4, Decision to Race.

15.2 The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
