#### 1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2 The applicable Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations shall apply.
- 1.3 Under RRS 86, Changes to the Racing Rules, the following racing rules will be changed as follows:
  - 1.3.1 RRS 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that after the first boat sails the course and finishes, a flouro yellow flag will be displayed from the race committee boat. Boats not on a windward leg shall proceed to the finish line to be scored Grand Prix Style,
  - 1.3.2 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two Turn Penalty is replaced with a Part turn penalty.
  - 1.3.3 RRS 44.2 is deleted
  - 1.3.4 RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to state that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches of some specific parts of the Sailing Instructions or Supplementary Sailing Instructions
  - 1.3.5 RRS A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored as a Did Not Start.
  - 1.3.6 RSS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42 may be applied as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
  - 1.3.7 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions and Supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be on the official notice board located in the BOIYC club house.
  - 1.3.8 RSS Appendix T Arbitration will apply
  - 1.3.9 Crash helmets are recommended to be worn at all times while afloat. Depending on the conditions the race officer has the right to make helmets compulsory for individual days of sailing.
  - 1.3.10 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

## 2 Advertising

- 2.1 Sailors may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.
- 2.2 It is compulsory to wear the regatta identification bib.

### 3 Eligibility

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all Waspz boats that comply with the Waspz class rules.
  - 3.1.1 Click Here for Class Rules
- 3.2 All competitors shall be fully paid up members of a club recognised by the competitor's national authority and a current member of the New Zealand Waspz Association or competitors country equivalent.
- 3.3 All competitors must have registered sail numbers.
- 3.4 International Competitors shall comply with World Sailing Eligibility Code (Regulation 19).
- 3.5 The following must be provided upon registration:
  - 3.5.1 Proof of affiliated club and class association membership
  - 3.5.2 Evidence of valid third party insurance.
  - 3.5.3 Proof of Age (if requested)
  - 3.5.4 Parental Permission for those under the age of 18.

### 4 Entry

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$185

- 4.3 Entries must be received by 23:59 31st January 2020.
- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted up to 9am 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 2020 and subject to a \$50 late fee

# 5 Schedule of Regatta

The 2020 WASZP Nationals will be held during the 2020 Foil Bay of Islands Regatta. All competitors are welcome to participate in those scheduled events Monday 10th Feb Thursday 13th Feb. Appendix C is the Foiling Week Program.

- 5.1 9 Races are scheduled with a target time of 20 minutes
- 5.2 On Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> Feb, no warning signals will be made after 15:00 hrs
- 5.3 Updates to schedules and other regatta information will also be posted on the Foil Bay of Islands Team App.

# 6 Equipment and Measurement

- 6.1 Measurement is not required but each boat must comply with their class rules at all times of the regatta
- 6.2 Competitors are required to sign a declaration at registration stating that their boat complies with class rules, including any exemptions published by the Waszp Association of NZ for the 2020 Nationals
- 6.3 Competitors may choose to sail with either a 6.9m2 or an 8.2m2 rig. The rig to be used for the regatta shall be declared at registration. No swapping of rig sizes during the regatta will be permitted.
- 6.4 Spot equipment and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.

## 7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board in the Bay of Yacht Club at registration.

### 8 Venue

- 8.1 The Race Office will be the club rooms of the Bay of Islands Yacht Club 2 Tau Henare Drive Waitangi See Appendix A.
- 8.2 The races will be held on water off Waitangi see Appendix B.

### 9 Courses

- 9.1 The Courses for the day will be displayed on the official notice board. Details will be supplied in the Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 The Race Officer may, in their absolute discretion, elect a 'non-foiling, no port-tack' start option. This start, if applied, will be described in the Sailing Instructions

## 10 Penalty System

- 10.1 Appendix P may apply.
- 10.2 The Racing Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by a Part Turn Penalty
  - 10.2.1 Part Turn Penalty is defined as
- 10.3 When on a leg of the course to windward mark, she shall gybe and as soon as reasonably possible luff to close hauled course
- 10.4 When on a leg of the course to a leeward mark or the finishing line, she shall tack and as soon as reasonably possible, bear away to a course that is more than 90deg from the true wind.

## 11 Scoring

- 11.1 5 races are required to constitute a series
- 11.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3 When 5 to 7 races have been completed, score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4 When 8 or more races have been completed, score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst 2 scores.

# 12 Support Boats

- 12.1 Support boats must register with the Race Office.
- 12.2 Support boats may be asked to assist the Race Officer

# 13 Launching

- 13.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority all competitors and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the Bay of Islands Yacht Club
- 13.2 Support boats must use the public boat ramp at Waitangi.

#### 14 Radio Communication

14.1 Except in emergency, a boat shall neither make or receive radio transmissions while racing that are not available to all boats. This restriction includes mobile phones.

### 15 GPS Devices

15.1 During long distance races each sailor may be asked to carry a signaling or tracking device and/or application associated with the sailor's mobile phone.

### 16 Awards

16.1 A minimum of 3 entries are required to constitute a division. For age divisions the skipper shall be under or over the age group as of 14<sup>th</sup> Feb 2019

16.2 1<sup>st</sup> Overall Andrew MacDougall Trophy

16.3 1<sup>st</sup> Youth (under 19) Henry Haslett Trophy

16.4 1<sup>st</sup> Master (over 45) Jon Bilger Trophy

16.5 1<sup>st</sup> Female Sara Winther Trophy.

## 17 Disclaimer of Liability

17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

# 18 Media Rights, Cameras and Electronic Equipment

18.1 By entering the regatta, competitors automatically grant the Organising Authority and

their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show from time to time at their

discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and

other reproductions of them or their equipment, taken during the period of the regatta,

for the said regatta as defined in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions in which

he/she participates without compensation.

18.2 Competitors may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment, or positioning

equipment as specified by the Organising Authority.

19 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a

minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent. Certificate of insurance is to be

presented at registration.
