1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Lifejackets shall be worn at all times. YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 On the water judging may be used for this event, in which case a modified addendum Q will apply. The addendum is attached to the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.4 RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.5 Appendix T, *Arbitration*, will apply.

2.0 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising as supplied by the Organising Authority.

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to teams (including the skipper) of 3 or 4 sailors from South Island Clubs. All registered crew shall sail all races.
- 3.2 The maximum total crew weight determined prior to racing shall be 262.5kg, when wearing at least shorts and shirt.
- 3.3 The Helmsperson and crew will be full time Y9 Y13 students at a Secondary School.
- 3.4 The Helmsperson and crew shall each be full members of a club affiliated to YNZ.
- 3.5 The regatta will be sailed in Elliott 6's as supplied by the Naval Point Club Lyttelton..
- 3.6 The expression of interest form must be received before 1700 Friday 25 September 2020.
- 3.7 The entry fee of \$100 per team must be received by 1700 Friday 16 October 2020.
- 3.8 Damage Deposit
 - (a) An initial damage deposit of \$600 per club team shall be paid at registration, completed before registration, unless extended by the Organising Authority (OA).
 This deposit is the maximum payable by the skipper as a result of any one incident
 - (b) In the event of a deduction being made from the damage deposit, the OA may require the deposit be restored to its original amount before the skipper be permitted to continue in the event.
 - (c) Any remaining deposit at the conclusion of the event will be refunded within 10 days of the event.



4.0 Format

- 4.1 The regatta will consist of a Qualifying series and a Final series.
- 4.2 Qualifying Series Teams will be divided into fleets by the OA. Up to six races for each fleet are scheduled. The qualifying format will depend on the number of entries received and will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 4.3 Final Series (Monday) Up to three races are scheduled for the SILVER fleet and up to five races are scheduled for the GOLD fleet. The number of races may be reduced at the discretion of the OA.

- 5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal on Saturday is 1025 and on the following two days 0955. A total of six (6) qualifying races are scheduled per fleet and then three (3) races for the Silver final fleet and five (5) for the Gold final fleet.
- 5.3 The warning signal for a subsequent race on the same day will be made as soon as practicable after the finish of the last boat in the preceding race.
- 5.4 On Monday 26 October, no warning signal will be made after 1530 hours.

6.0 Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available online from 16 October 2020 or at Registration.

7.0 The Courses

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward.

8.0 Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply.
- 8.2 Qualifying Series Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 Final Series Three races for the Gold & Silver Fleets are required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.0 Prizes

- 9.1 The winner of the GOLD fleet will be awarded the; Professionals South Island Inter Club Youth Regatta Trophy.
- 9.2 Other prizes will be awarded.
