## Youth Regional Support Plan

## Purpose:

Offset the travel costs for regional sailors to come and attend Aon national clinics in Auckland

## Key Clinics to target for 2020/21:

- $\quad 28^{\text {th }}-30^{\text {th }}$ of September Manly Sailing Club
- $\quad 21^{\text {st }}-23^{\text {rd }}$ of December Venue TBC
- $18^{\text {th }}-21^{\text {st }}$ of January Venue TBC

Average cost for return airfares:

- Wellington: \$300
- Dunedin: \$500
- Christchurch: \$400
- Napier/New Plymouth \$250

Half of the cost of an average return airfare from their respective region will be paid to each sailor to attend Aon national clinics. The total amount available is $\$ 5000$. Each sailor can apply for a maximum of two clinics per season. Double handed sailors will have to apply separately to both receive the funding.

If there are funds remaining after all selections have been decided, the remaining amount will be distributed between all sailors that applied for the support.

A selection panel will decide who receives the support. Geoff Woolley, Rosie Chapman and one independent appointed person will be on the selection panel. Yachting New Zealand regional support officers may be consulted for more information on the sailors.

Funds to go directly to the parents of the sailor.
The YNZ Youth Coordinator can assist sailors with finding boats and billets.

## Selection Criteria:

Selection panel have full discretion based upon the following:

- Previous results within the last 9 months. Including top 5 results from national events, ranking events and any international events. Including year, class, event name and placing.
- Upcoming major events between July 2020 and June 2021
- Training plan on and off the water
- Include event date, event name including location, class and your goal for each event.
- Eligibility to compete at the 2021 Youth Sailing World Championship

Applications close September $6^{\text {th }} 2020$.
