



Notice of Race

Note: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-20 ("RRS").
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. Appendix S shall apply.
- 1.4. Appendix T shall apply. 2.

Advertising

2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Sunburst class.
- 3.2. Eligible skippers may enter by completing the online registration at

https://www.registernow.com.au/secure/Register.aspx?E=40690

By 5pm 16 October

- 3.3. Late entries. A late entry may be accepted at the Organising Authority's discretion until 9am 17 October 2020
- 3.4. To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by their national authority. Proof of affiliated club membership is to be submitted with the entry or presented at the time of registration.

4. Fees

4.1. The entry fee is \$65.00

5.3. Number of Races

- (a) 7 Races are scheduled for the series. (b)
 - Up to 7 races may be sailed per day.
- (c) The target time for each race will be 30 minutes for the leading boat.
- (d) On Sunday 18th October, no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

5.4 Evening Meal

Saturday 17th October following the completion of racing a BBQ buffet meal can be booked Cost\$25.00 for Adults \$15 for Children

6. Measurement

- 6.1.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and shall display a current registration sticker on its transom.
- 6.1.2 All sails shall have been previously measured and stamped by a Sunburst Class Measurer.
- 6.1.3 There shall be only one set of sails, spars and foils used by each boat. These shall be presented and endorsed at Registration. (refer NOR5.1 above).

Any changes must be requested and approved by the Race Officer in writing.

6.1.4 Each boat shall complete a measurement/safety checklist during the registration process.

Entrants are encouraged to undertake this process on Friday 16th October due to the tight time constraints on Saturday 17th October. (refer NOR5.1 above).

- 6.1.5 There will be no sail, boat or foil measurement at the event unless previously arranged with a Sunburst Class Measurer.
- 6.2 All beach trailers/trolleys must have boat names and sail numbers clearly marked on them.
- 6.3 Safety and measurement checks may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

7. Sailing Instructions

7.1. Printed Sailing Instructions will not be made available. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be posted on the PLBC Website by 0900 on Monday 12th October 2020 and a copy will also be posted on the Official Notice Board.

8. Venue

- 8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue and the racing area.
- 8.2. The racing area is on the waters adjacent to The Plimmerton Boating Club.

9. Courses to be Sailed

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be triangular courses including windward, reaching and leeward marks.

10. Penalty System

10.1. Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the 'Two-Turns' penalty is replaced by the 'One-Turn' Penalty.

11. Scoring

- 11.1. 4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will the total of her race scores.
- 11.3. When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. Launching

12.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from PLBC Dinghy Ramp

13. Coaching and Support Boats

13.1. Support boats are allowed.

14. Radio Communication

14.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP].

15. Prizes

15.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

15.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

16. Insurance

16.1 It is highly recommended that each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance to a minimum of \$1,000,000

17. Disclaimer of Liability

17.1 Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.
