#### NOTICE OF RACE

NB: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

PLEASE NOTE: FOR 12FT SKIFF, WASZP & FLYING DUTCHMAN THIS IS A 3 DAY EVENT, FOR ALL OTHER FLEETS IT WILL BE A 2 DAY EVENT!!!!

- 1 RULES
- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulation

Centreboard & Open Yachts shall comply with Part I.

Trailer Yachts and Sports Trailer Yachts shall comply with Part V category C.

Keel Yachts shall comply with Part II, category 4.

Sports Boats shall comply with Part VI, category B.

- 1.3 For the keel yacht, multi hull, skiff & trailer yacht classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- **1.4** The Sailing Instructions may change further racing rules.
- **1.5** Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.
- 2 ADVERTISING
- Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]
- 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY
- **3.1** Racing is open to boats of all classes. Boats and competitors must comply with their class rules.

- **3.3** EARLY BIRD ENTRIES as listed below will be accepted until 1700 hours on Saturday 21 November 2020:
  - \$45.00 for Optimist, Starling & O'pen Skiff Classes
  - \$65.00 for Zephyr, Europe, Laser, OK Dinghy, Paper Tiger, Finn & Europe Classes
  - \$85.00 for Div 1, Div 2, Noelex 25, Flying Fifteen, Open, Sports Boat Classes
  - \$105.00 for Flying Dutchman, Waszp, 12ft Skiff (THESE FLEETS ARE RACING 3 DAYS)

Entries received after the Early Bird Entry Fee deadline will be accepted until 1700 hours on Tuesday 24 November 2020 however an additional fee of \$20 will be charged on top of the Early Bird Entry Fee.

3.4 To be eligible to compete, each competitor, and each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a member club of Yachting New Zealand (YNZ), or of a club recognised by that person's national authority.

**4.4** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1530hrs.

#### **5 MEASUREMENT**

- **5.1** Each boat maybe asked to produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 5.2 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 throughout the contest and may be checked at any time during the event.
- **5.3** A Safety Declaration is to be completed at registration. NB; a safety check may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

#### **6** SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 0900Hrs on Monday 23 November 2020 from the Napier sailing club website.

#### 7 VENUE

- **7.1** Attachment A; shows the location of the regatta venue.
- **7.2** Attachment B; shows the location of the racing area.

#### 8 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will consist of: Windward / Leeward, Triangles or a mixture of both.

#### 9 SCORING

**9.1** 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.2

- a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 5 races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 10 SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall Register with the Organising Authority. [DP]

#### 11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the boat park. [DP]

#### 12 LAUNCHING & RETRIEVAL RESTRICTIONS

Competitors shall launch and retrieve vessels from Napier Sailing Club Ramps during the regatta except with, and according to the terms of, prior written permission of the race committee. [DP]

#### 13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

#### 14 PRIZES

Prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority in conjunction with the Class Association

#### 15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat should be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

#### 16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 17 Event Cancellation

In the event of cancellation due to any causes outside of the Organising Authority control all efforts will be made to reimburse Entry fees less any Event associated cost already incurred not recoverable.
