



2021 New Zealand 420 National Championships 2021 420 Open World Championship Team Selection Trials

Friday 2nd – Monday 5th April 2021

The Organising Authority is Canterbury Yachting Assn in conjunction with NPCL

Note: The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS").
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. Appendix P, shall apply.
- 1.4. Appendix T shall apply.

2. Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the International 420 Class.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and either

- 3.3. Late entries, accompanied by the late entry fee may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until 1000hrs on Tuesday 30th March 2021.

3.4. To be eligible to compete in this regatta each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of their national 420 class association, and a club recognised by their national authority. Proof of class association and club membership is to be submitted with the entry or presented at the time of registration.

4. Fees

4.1. The entry fee for all classes is \$200.00.

4.2. The late entry fee is \$250 (\$200.00 + \$50.00 late fee) if received after 21st March 2021.

5. Schedule

5.1. Registration

Friday 2nd April 2021 0800-1000hrs NPCL

5.2. Briefing

The briefing is scheduled for 1000hrs on Friday 2nd April 2021 upstairs in the NPCL Club

5.3. Dates of Racing

5.4. Number of Races

(a) 12 races are scheduled for the series.

(b) On Monday April 5th, no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

6. Measurement

6.1. Each boat shall provide a valid measurement certificate no later than at the time of registration. In addition, spot measurements and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the regatta.

6.2. Measurement will not be available at the regatta. All boats and equipment must be pre-measured. Please contact the 420 Class Measurer, John Thompson (09 444 8165) to prearrange boat and sail measurement.

6.3. All beach trolleys shall have their boat numbers clearly marked on them.

7. Sailing Instructions

7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at the time of registration and may also be posted on the NPCL website.

8. Venue

8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.

8.2. The Racing Area is the waters of Lyttleton Harbour.

9. Courses to be Sailed

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be Trapezoid and/or Windward/Leeward.

10. Scoring

10.1. 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

10.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.3. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

11. Launching

11.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from the ramps in front of the NPCL.

12. Coaching and Support Boats

12.1. All support boats must register with the Organising Authority at the time of Registration (refer to 5.1 above) and nominate which boat(s) they are supporting. [DP].

13. Radio Communication

13.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones [DP].

14. Prizes

14.1. Prizes will be provided by the NZ 420 Class Association and awarded as follows:

- Trophy for First Overall
- Trophy for First Women's Team

14.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the NZ 420 Class Association or the Organising Authority.

15. Selection

15.1. If a 420 Worlds are held in 2021 the Team will be selected using the results of this event.

15.2. Up to seven open crews and up to seven women's crews will be selected according to New Zealand 420 Association Selection Policy, to represent New Zealand at the 2021 Open 420 and Women's World Championships.

15.3. Entries for the U17 World Championship shall be limited in accordance with the International 420 Class Association Guidelines: 6 boats (3 boats open + 3 boats women's).

16. Insurance

16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance of a minimum of \$1,000,000. Proof of insurance shall be provided no later than the close of registration.

17. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 3. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.

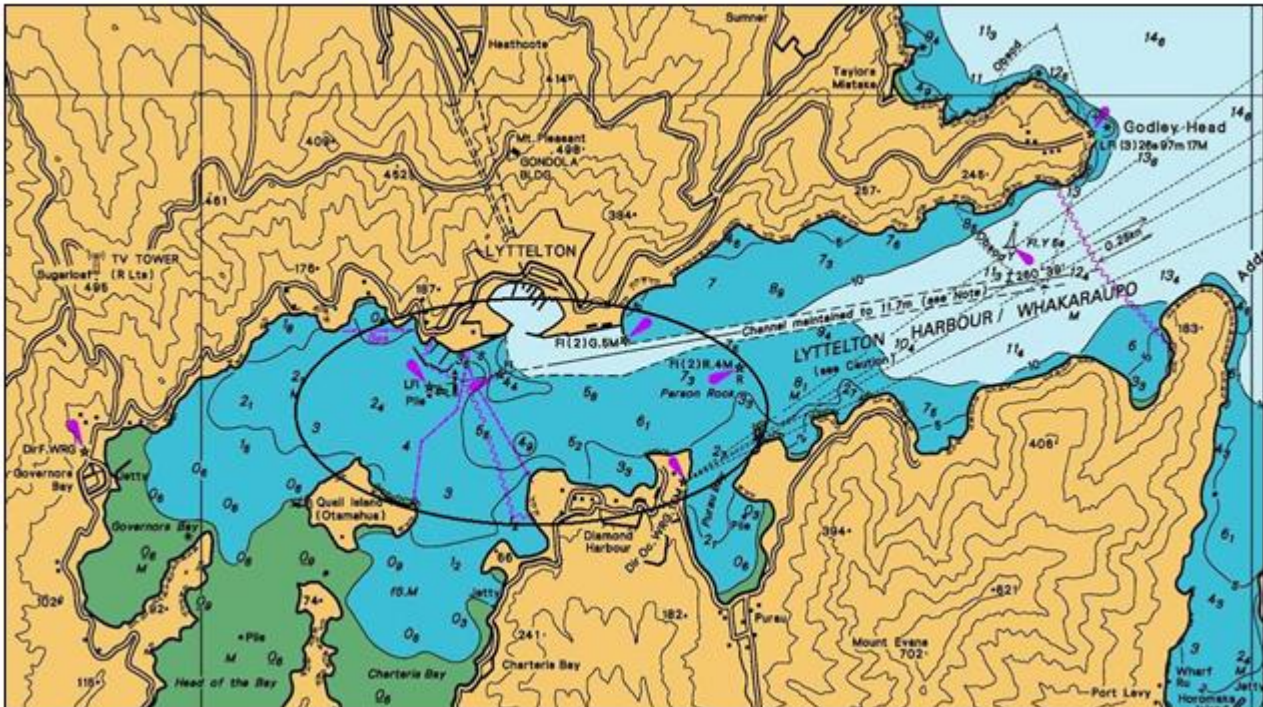
Attachment A – Regatta Venue
