2022 Cambridge Yacht Club Regatta February 5 & 6, 2022

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Yachting New Zealand Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 Changes to Rules: Will be notified in the Sailing Instructions. Notices will be posted on the official notice board by 0930 hours on the day it is to take effect from.

2.0 Changes to Rules

2.1 Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed
The two-turn penalty shall be replaced with a one turn penalty which will consist of one tack and one gybe.

3.0 Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all sailors who are members of a yacht club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 3.2 Racing is open to boats of all centreboard classes up to 4.7m. Boats must comply with individual class rules.
- 3.3 **NORMAL ENTRIES** will be accepted until 2000 hours on 1 Feb 2021, by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of:
 - \$30.00 for Junior Classes; Optimist, P. Open Skiff, and Starling
 - \$40.00 for all other single handed boats and
 - \$60.00 for all crewed boats
- 3.4 Advance entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of 1 Feb 2021, by attaching the attached entry form/s accompanied by an online bank transfer to cambridgevc@xtra.co.nz. An online form is also available to submit.
- 3.5 Late entries will incur an additional \$10 fee.
- 3.6 By starting a boat acknowledges that an entry fee is payable. If no entry fee is paid before or on the day of racing no results will be published for that boat and the boat will be ineligible for prizes





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4.0 Schedule of Events.

4.1 Racing schedule will be at the discretion of the Race Officer as conditions allow.

5.0 Sailing Instructions

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

6.0 Racing Area

6.1 Racing will be held on the water of Lake Karapiro in Lake Zones 4, 5, 6 & 7

7.0 Courses to be Sailed

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be a combination of short triangle windward/leeward, and random leg courses. The courses may be relatively short to allow for more races and will be identified further in the Sailing Instructions and posted on the notice board in the clubhouse.

8.0 Scoring

- 8.1 The Low Points Scoring System will be used.
- 8.2 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 - (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.3 A minimum of three (3) boats will be required to form a fleet, classes will be combined to form open (mixed class) fleets at the race committee's discretion.

 Mixed class fleets will be scored under the Weymouth Class Handicap as published by Yachting NZ.

9.0 Support Boats

9.1 Support boats will not be permitted on the course during a race, additional safety boats welcome.

10.0 Prize Giving and Spot Prizes

10.1 Prize Giving will be held at Cambridge Yacht Club as soon as possible after racing is completed.

11.0 Radio Communication

11.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing, nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.



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12.0 Disclaimer of liability

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4,
Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material
damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during,
or after the regatta.

13.0 Insurance

13.1 The organising authority recommends that each boat carry current 3rd party liability insurance.
