

The Yachting New Zealand Aon Youth Programme (AYP) code of behavior will apply to all sailors, coaches and support personnel attending clinics and YNZ national and international events.

- 1. Sailors are responsible for turning up to each Aon Clinic fully prepared for physical training, theory, note taking and ready to sail on time.
 - AYP members are responsible for their own property;
 - AYP members are responsible for their boats and associated equipment;
 - Sailors should be prepared to sail in all conditions;
 - Sailors should respect other people's boats and equipment
- 2. AYP sailors should attend each clinic and event with a positive attitude and uphold the value of the YNZ youth programme:
 - Drive to be your best
 - Enjoy their sailing
 - Be open to working together and sharing information as a squad and as a wider AYP group
 - Contribute to group discussions
 - Be grateful for the opportunities provided in each clinic and within the sport of sailing
- 3. To ensure that the reputation of the AYP is maintained at the highest level and that the wellbeing of all participants is respected:
 - AYP members are to conduct themselves at all times in a manner which promotes the good name of the AYP and youth sailing in NZ.
 - Behavior which could endanger the well-being of others will not be tolerated.
 - Any bullying of other sailors and program participants will not be tolerated.
 - AYP members are to treat their coach, opposition, training partners and support personnel with respect and courtesy at all times.
