Course Outline Advanced Sea Survival Training

Yachting New Zealand reminds all skippers of their paramount duty to manage all risks on board and pay particular attention to those manoeuvres that carry high levels of risk. Proper training and practice is an essential part of the Skipper's duty. It is essential that training includes simulation of emergencies using the most realistic scenario possible.


SR Appendix 6 of the Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations of Sailing requires at least 30% of the crew including the skipper to have undertaken advanced sea survival training within five years before the start of any voyage where Advanced Sea Survival is required.

For races, some race committees will require more than 30% of the crew to be trained.

Training includes:

- History, statistics and legislation
- Accidents and emergencies
- Equipment
- Safety and emergency planning
- Risk assessment
- Man overboard, life rafts and equipment
- Distress signals and responsibilities
- Wet drill
- SAR systems and responsibilities
- Fire precautions and fire fighting
- Medical care aboard
- Damage control
- Weather and forecasting
- Heavy weather techniques
- Storm sails
