NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 2024
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2, or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the dinghy class(es)
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form, and paying the required fee, when registering prior to racing on Saturday 28 January 2023
- 2.3 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club recognized by the competitor's national authority
- 2.4 Four or more boats are required to form a class, otherwise boats will race in open divisions and handicap ratings applied
- 2.5 Races will be started with a three-minute start sequence.

3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: Saturday 28 January 2023, from 9am to start of first race
- 4.2 Initial Briefing 10 AM Saturday
- 4.3 Schedule to be announced at the briefing
- 4.4 A delayed sailing session (mid afternoon to early evening) is possible if weather conditions dictate

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 9am on Saturday 28 January 2023 at Marakura Yacht Club

6 RACING AREA

6.1 On Lake Te Anau in the area adjacent to Marakura Yacht Club

7 THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows: Trapezoid or others as set by the race officer

8 SCORING

- 8.1 The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply
- 8.2 No score will be excluded until 5 races have been completed and a boat's worst score will be excluded when 6 or more races have been completed (subsequent drops will happen after multiples of 5 races are complete)

9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

9.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prize giving will be held as soon as possible after last race Sunday afternoon

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

11.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk: See rule 4, Decision to Race.
