1.0 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations (Part 1 shall apply for eligible yachts)
- 1.3 For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty

2.0 ADVERTISING

2.1 The Organizing Authority may require all participating boats to display the event sponsor's advertising.

3.0 DIVISIONS

- 3.1 Various (Junior / Intermediate / Senior // Trailer Sailors // etc)
 - (There may be some alteration to the above Division's dependent on entries)
- 3.2 Any class with five or more boats competing may be scored as its own division.
- 3.3 Times for the open divisions will be adjusted by YNZ Handicaps (Based on the earlier Weymouth Yard Stick)

4.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEE

- 4.2 Any boat modification to be declared on entry.
- 4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form along with their entry fee at registration on the day. \$10.00 Junior / \$20 Senior NOTE: Cash Only for all payments (No electronic payment available)

- 9.2 One race will be required to be completed to constitute a series. All races to count.

12.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Racing Rule 3, Decision to Race.
The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
It is the intention that if the forecast / conditions are greater than 20 knots, then sailing will not proceed.
