

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Assessment Guideline

Yachting New Zealand

Any applicant for an RPL for a Yachting New Zealand (YNZ) qualification will be required to complete the online learning module “Coaching Yachting 101” to familiarise themselves with New Zealand safety guidelines and coaching standards, and the online module “Child Safeguarding”.

Assistant Learn to Sail Coach

This qualification describes a coach who is either under the age of 18 or does not meet all of the requirements for a full Learn to Sail Coach. Any coach wishing to be recognised as an Assistant LTS Coach will need to have the requirements as per the chart below.

Learn to Sail Coach

This qualification describes a coach who is over the age of 18 and has sufficient experience coaching and leading Learn to Sail groups.

Head Coach

This qualification describes a coach who is over the age of 18 and has extensive experience coaching Learn to Sail and has experience as a Head Coach of a yacht club. Some form of Child Safeguarding training is required to achieve this qualification, as well as a written recommendation from a club where you have been Head Coach.

Race Coach

This qualification describes a coach who has experience coaching at regattas of a sufficient level (ie. nationals or regional level) and can show evidence of self-development and continuous learning in coaching. A Learn to Sail Coach wishing to obtain this qualification can take the Yachting New Zealand Race Coach course online on Embark and have an in-person or video submission assessment.

Performance Coach

This qualification describes a coach who has experience coaching at an international level (ie. Youth Worlds or Opti Worlds or equivalent/higher) and can show evidence of self-development and continuous learning in coaching. Applications for this level of coaching will be considered individually and assessments will be tailored to unique situations.
