- 6. Once the application period has closed, HPSNZ will engage with your NSO, and your application, if endorsed, will be ranked and prioritised against the criteria outlined in the PMAS Programme Guide.

- The awarding of a PMAS is made according to the PMAS Programme Guide; applying for a PMAS does not guarantee approval.
- Applications for the primary intake of Prime Minister's Athlete Scholarships will open on 1 November 2023, and close at 5pm on 27 November 2023. This intake is for the purpose of education in the 2024 academic year. Applications received after 5pm on 27 November will not be accepted for assessment.
- A secondary intake, which is for the purpose of education in the second half of the 2024 academic year only, closes on 31 May 2024. This intake is only for Athletes who are invited to apply, or who have had changes occur to their 2024 sporting or academic commitments. Please note that the second intake is subject to availability of funds for the Prime Minister Scholarship Programme.
- If you have not applied for a scholarship before you will need to register at scholarships.hpsnz.org.nz/hpsnz_register.
- If you have applied previously, please DO NOT RE-REGISTER, use your existing login details to complete your application, If you cannot remember your login details please email pmscholarships@hpsnz.org.nz and you'll be sent this information.
