Specific Responsibilities:

- Follow Bucklands Beach Yacht Club Health & Safety Procedures
- Help run and plan the Learn to Sail programmes during the season
- Developing the skills of sailors through YNZ Learn to Sail programmes
- Coaching students to respect boats and equipment
- Coaching students about the fundamentals of sailing and the surrounding environment
- Focus on junior and youth fleets using the Optimist and other yachts.
- Mentor young Sailors
- Coach the School RUNA Sail Experience Programmes
- Report damage and breakdown when they occur to the Sailing Academy Supervisor
- Complete an attendance register before and after sailing to ensure all students are accounted for. The register is to be emailed to the Sailing Academy administrator coach@bbyc.org.nz on the Sunday or Monday morning after each session
- Wash and clean all the yachts and rescue craft and their associated storage areas
- Participation in other club activities as required
