

New Zealand Youth Championships – Equipment Measurement

Measurement will take place for all classes between 12pm and 4pm inside the shed at MBSC. You can measure anytime within the four-hour window. Access to the measurement area will be restricted to competitors only. Following measurement, boats must be taken directly to the competitors only rigging area. Designated class rigging areas will be shared prior.

Your boat must be clean and dry – please remove all items that are not required for measurement; examples are extra mast sections and extra sails, foil and sail bags, etc.

Each class will be checked and need to declare the following for the event:

29ers:

- Sails: serial number on main, jib and gennaker
- Forestay length
- Hull weight: Min 74 kg
- Hull corrector weights: Boats are to be presented dry and correctors shall not exceed 2kg.
- Mast chocks: Number and thickness
- Sail numbers: on hull and trailer

420s:

- Sails: serial number on main, jib and spinnaker.
- Boats are to be presented for full measurement dry.
- Boats will be allocated to a check of hull of 80kg as per CR D.5 or 100kg as per CR C.6.1.
- The list which hull check each boat will be allocated to and any further instructions will be shared on the noticeboard prior.

iQFOIL

- Board, sail, and foils to be presented for QR code check.

ILCAS

- Please prepare your equipment with only the lower section on and the boom rigged with all control lines.
- Put all other equipment on the deck of your boat.
- You will be asked to verify on the measurement form your hull, sail, and foil number.

Following the inspection process, your form will be signed by a Regatta Measurer, and you will be able to register for the regatta which is also inside the shed.
