SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SSI)

This sheet and Addendum A are supplements to Appendix S of the Racing Rules of Sailing (*page 176 RRS 2025-2028*).

RULES

SSI 1 Refer to the Notice of Race

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS (SI 2)

SSI 2 The race office is located near the main entrance on the ground floor of the Naval Point Club House, Marina Way, Lyttelton.

SSI 3 The official notice board is located at

SSI 4 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 77. Failure to receive a broadcast will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 61.1

SIGNALS MADE ASHORE (SI 4)

SSI 5 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagstaff located at Eastern side of the Naval Point Club house adjacent to the launching ramp.

SSI 6 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

SSI 7 On Sunday, 8th February no warning signal will be made after 1530.

COURSES (SI 7)

SSI 8 The course to be sailed, the order in which the marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left are shown in SSI Addendum A.

SSI 9 In the event that a gate mark is missing and has not been replaced with an object displaying flag M, the remaining mark shall be rounded to port.

MARKS (SI 8)

SSI 10 The description of the marks is in the table in SSI Addendum A.

THE START (SI 9)

SSI 11 A boat starting later than four minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and 5.2.

TIME LIMITS (SI 12)

Note The is no time limit for Mark 1.

CHECK OUT AND CHECK IN

SSI 12 Boats shall comply with the following check out and check in procedure: A sign out and sign in sheet will be on clipboard on the counter outside the race office. Boats are required to sign out before going out on the water and sign in immediately when coming ashore.


SUPPORT VESSELS

SSI 13 All official and support vessels shall always have an engine safety cut out switch (kill cord) attached to the driver while the engine is running, unless prior written exemption has been provided by the Organising Authority.

s Finishing mark starboard end	Small orange spherical buoy
p Finishing mark port end	Committee Boat with blue flag on staff
