NOTICE OF RACE

The notation [NP] in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1. The notation [DP] is defined in the RRS introduction.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The Zephyr Class rules will apply.
- 1.4 Appendix T, Arbitration may apply.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and Supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be displayed on the Nelson Yacht Club Notice Board.
- 2.2 The Sailing Instructions will be available from 25th January 2027 on the Nelson Yacht Club website: www.nelsonyachtclub.org.nz

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The official website is here: <https://www.nelsonyachtclub.org.nz/racing-and-regattas/> and the event WhatsApp group.
- 3.2 The official notice board is located on the door of the lower lounge at Nelson Yacht Club.
- 3.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

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4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Zephyr Owners' Association that comply with the Class Rules. See [Zephyr Owners' Association website - Zephyr Class Rules](#)
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the contest Entry Form on the Nelson Yacht Club website <https://www.nelsonyachtclub.org.nz> and depositing the required Entry Fee as per instructions on the Entry Form.
- 4.3 Entries will be accepted until the closing date of 11th February 2027 at 2000hrs. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority, until 1 March 2027 at 2000hrs.
- 4.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a financial member of a club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 4.5 Each competitor shall be a member of the Zephyr Owners' Association. See the Zephyr Owners' Association website for membership registration - [Membership Registration Form](#)

- 6.1 [DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

7.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

8 EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

8.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate held by the Zephyr Owners' Association.

8.2 Boats may be inspected at any time.

8.3 Items to be checked at measurement will be advised to all participants prior to measurement. Additional items may be spot checked during regatta.

9 VENUE

9.1 The venue is the Nelson Yacht Club, 322 Wakefield Quay, Nelson.

10 COURSES

10.1 The course(s) to be sailed will be triangle and/or windward/leeward.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12 SCORING

- 12.1 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 12.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 12.3 When from 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

13 SUPPORT VESSELS [DP][NP]

- 13.1 Support vessel skippers should be familiar with Local Body by-laws regarding the wearing of PFDs. <https://www.nelson.govt.nz/6environment/harbour/recreational-boating/lifejackets>

- 13.2 All support vessels and the person in charge shall register with the Organising Authority at Registration.
- 13.3 All support vessels shall always have an engine safety cut out switch (kill cord) attached to the driver while the engine is running, unless prior written exemption has been provided by the Organising Authority.
- 13.4 All registered support vessels will carry on board and operate while on the water a VHF radio capable of transmitting and receiving on regatta VHF Channels and agree to assist the Race Committee if directed to do so.
- 13.5 There will be launch and retrieval facilities available at Nelson Marina launching ramp, Akersten St for support vessels.

14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS [DP][NP]

- 14.1 Unless otherwise directed, competitor's boats must launch and be retrieved from Nelson Yacht Club slipway.

15 RISK STATEMENT

- 15.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

16 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 16.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

17 USE OF DRONE FOR MEDIA

- 17.1 Drones / RPAS (Remote Piloted Aircraft System) under the control of the organising authority may be used during the event. Participation in the event will be taken as agreement and consent to be overflown by and have RPAS operate within close proximity to competing boats.

18 INSURANCE

- 18.1 Yachting New Zealand highly recommends that each participating boat be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

19 PRIZES

- 19.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
- Zephyr Championship Trophy
 - Zephyr Championship Runner-Up
 - Zephyr Handicap Trophy
 - Zephyr Championship Female
 - Zephyr Grand Master Trophy 75 + years
 - Only required to do the first two races each day for the 75 + category
 - Zephyr Master Trophy 70 – 74 years
 - Zephyr Master Trophy 65 – 69 years.
 - Zephyr Master Trophy 60 - 64 years
 - Zephyr Master Trophy 50 - 59 years.
 - Zephyr Female Master Trophy 50 + years
 - Zephyr Trophy 40 - 49 years.
 - First Townson Trophy
 - Most Improved Trophy
 - Whanau Trophy (Family related entries)
 - At least 2 people from different generations of an immediate family (not siblings only).
 - Best 2 positions per family per race recorded, worst can be dropped (as per usual rules).
 - Heavy Weight Trophy. To be eligible, a contestant's body weight shall be above 95kg. Entrants must opt-in to be eligible.
 - Fresh Breeze Trophy. To be eligible, contestants must correctly answer NO to all the following questions:
 1. Have you, as skipper, ever won a national sailing championship, in any country, any class of boat?
 2. Have you ever finished in the top 5 in a Zephyr National Championship?
 3. Have you ever been a member, in any capacity, of an Olympic, Americas Cup, or professional sailing team?
 4. Have you ever won the Zephyr Class Fresh Breeze Trophy?

Nelson Yacht Club – Regatta site plan



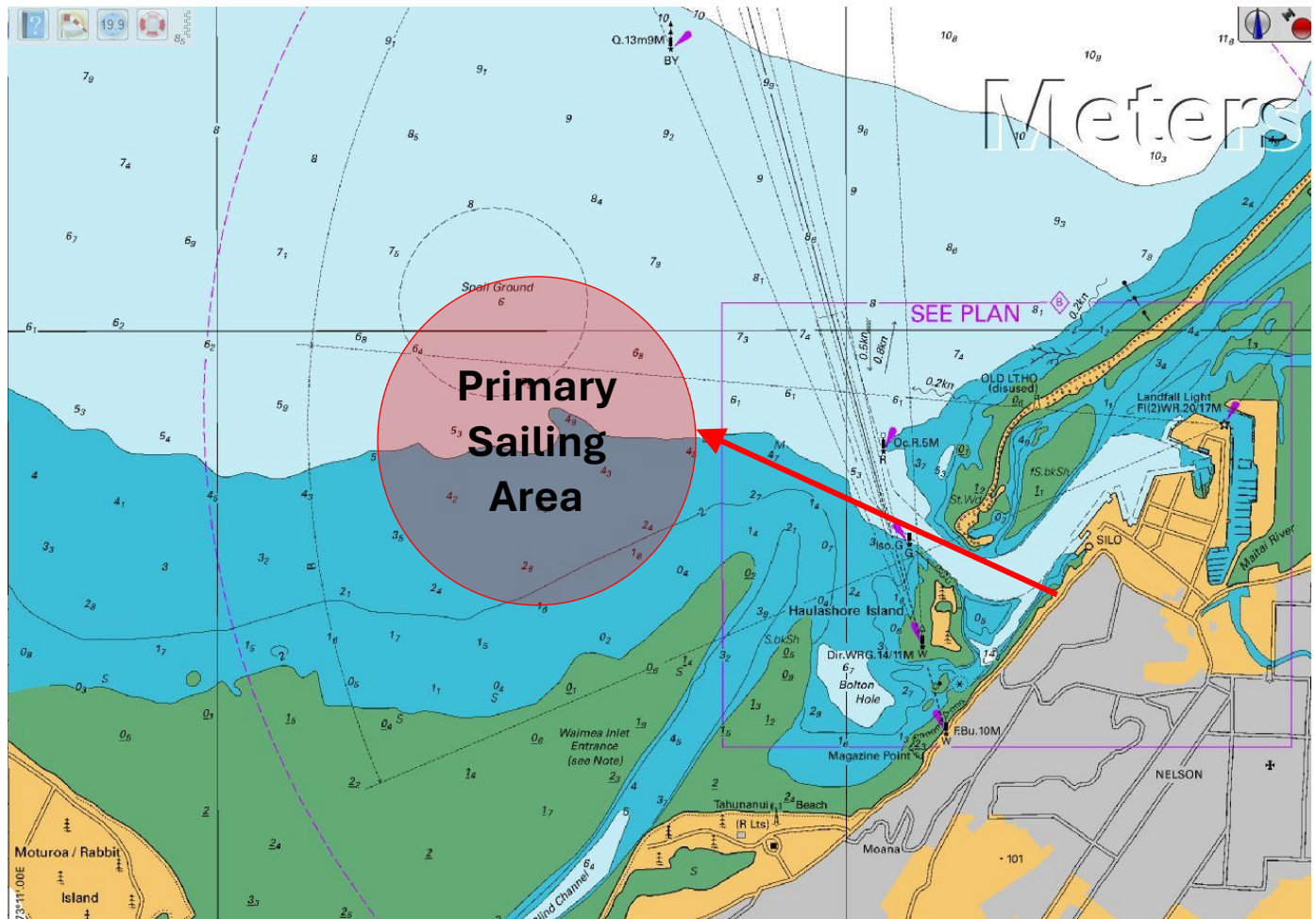
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Addendum B: LOCATION OF SAILING/RACING AREA
