To form a fleet, at least 5 boats of that class must enter. Classes with lower numbers will sail in an Open Fleet.
Scoring for the Open Fleet will be calculated based on the Weymouth Yard Stick as published by YNZ.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Registration:	Saturday	3 rd February	9.00am
Briefing:	Saturday	3 rd February	10.00am
First Warning Signal	Saturday	3 rd February	10.45am
Briefing:	Sunday	4 th February	9.45 am

Two or more back-to-back races may be scheduled per day, with a lunch break.
A maximum of 4 races on Saturday, and 3 on Sunday.
At the discretion of the Race Officer, if conditions have made racing conditions difficult, an early dinner break may be scheduled on Saturday and one or two races held in the evening following this break.
No warning signal for racing will be made after 2.00pm Sunday 4th February.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the notice board with copies available at the regatta.

5. RACING AREA

The races will be held on Lake Ngaroto, Te Awamutu.

6. COURSES TO BE SAILED

The courses will be windward/leeward/triangle or trapezoid

7. SCORING

The "low points" scoring of Appendix A will apply.

7.1 Three races must be completed to constitute a series.

7.2 Worst score to be dropped after the completion of four or more races.

8. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top place getters in each class.

For a class of only 5 boats there will be only one prize.

For larger fleets prizes will be awarded according to the size of the fleet and the availability of prizes, at the Race Committee's discretion.

9. TEAM SUPPORT BOATS are not permitted. (Except for Sailability)

10. Venue Catering Accommodation

An area for camping on site, a large grassed reserve for your tent, camper van. There will be a catered dinner Saturday night. The Club chefs will cook a breakfast for you on Sunday morning. The BBQ runs for lunch. Our shop has a few nibbles and drinks.

Reserve floodlit for your convenience and security. Sailing is right on the doorstep. Come along and enjoy the rural hospitality and sailing at Lake Ngaroto.
